Good afternoon, further to my keyworker letter this morning.

Treetops is open as usual for those parents who have already booked provision. This will be reviewed by the end of this week.

Keyworker email address: keyworker@nunnerywoodprimary.worcs.sch.uk .We are working tremendously hard to support our keyworker families.

1. Year R (Oak and Willow) keyworker bubble will be based in Early Years unit
2. Year 1 (Cherry and Chestnut) keyworker bubble will be based in Cherry classroom
3. Year 2 (Apple and Aspen) keyworker bubble will be based in Aspen classroom
4. Year 3 (Spruce and Sycamore) keyworker bubble will be based in Sycamore classroom
5. Year 4 (Lime and Lilac) keyworker bubble will be based in Lilac classroom
6. Year 5 (Maple and Mulberry) keyworker bubble will be based in Mulberry classroom
7. Year 6 (Holly and Hazel) keyworker bubble will be based in Holly classroom

- Children in the Year 2 (Apple and Aspen) keyworker bubble and the Year 1 (Chestnut and Cherry) keyworker bubble can be dropped off from 8.35am. Older siblings can be dropped off via the one way system.
- Children in the Year 6 (Hazel and Holly) keyworker bubble and the Year 4(Lilac and Lime) keyworker bubble must come on site from 8.45am and no earlier. This should be the majority of children.
- Children in Year R (Oak and Willow) keyworker bubble, Year 3 (Spruce and Sycamore) keyworker bubble, Year 5 (Maple and Mulberry) keyworker bubble must come onsite from 8.50am.
- The school gates are closed at 9am.

AFTERNOON PICK-UP

- Children in Year 2 (Apple and Aspen) keyworker bubble, Year 1(Chestnut and Cherry) keyworker bubble from 3.10pm. Once you have collected your child/children from their class please ensure that you keep them with you at all times.
- Children in the Year 6 (Hazel and Holly) keyworker bubble, Year 4(Lilac and Lime) keyworker bubble can be collected from 3.20pm. This should be the majority of children. Older children, who have permission, can leave their classroom at 3.20pm and walk out at South gate.
- Children in Year R (Oak and Willow) keyworker bubble, Year 3 (Spruce and Sycamore) keyworker bubble, Year 5 (Maple and Mulberry) keyworker bubble can be collected from 3.30pm.

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- Only children with brothers and sisters in Years 1 and 2 should be collected from 3.10pm. All other children should be collected later. Again, there is no rush, as staff will not leave their classrooms until all children have been collected.

What sort of things will children be doing in a keyworker year group bubble?

Our plan is to offer children a range of activities over the week. Supporting their online learning will be a priority as well as art & craft, sport, computing, games – indoor and outdoor, gardening, and forest school. Children will also have the opportunity to complete learning activities being sent out by class teachers, just like the children who are not able to come to school. Please continue to email your child's class teacher if you have any questions.

Where will the children be working?

They will be working within a classroom in year group bubble. We will hope to use outdoor spaces as much as possible.

What are the arrangements for lunch for keyworker children?

Please ensure that your child has a packed lunch and a bottle of water. Currently we are organising for all the children who are entitled Free School Meals to have their FSM food delivered by Morrisons which we used in the autumn term when we closed a year group bubble. Further information will be sent directly to those parents whose children are entitled to FSM.

What's happening over the half-term holiday?

Currently we don't know the government's expectations.

What do the children need to bring to school tomorrow if they are in a keyworker bubble?

Children will be expected to wear normal school uniform.

Please bring:

- P.E Kit
- Outdoor Kit- Woodland clothes
- A coat
- A water bottle
- A healthy snack – the free fruit and vegetable scheme for schools has now been suspended
- A packed lunch
- Your child's medication (if applicable)

Remote Learning

It is now a national lockdown, which is different to a year group bubble closure. We have had to adapt our remote learning package to support all our families as many parents have shared that they are under pressure to support all their children at home. Year R and Year 1 will be using Tapestry and Years 2-6 will be using Google Classroom. The work set will be the same for the keyworker children in school. You will

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be able to request a printed pack - should it be required, via your child's teacher once they have contacted you by email first.

As everybody is now working remotely (except those in Keyworker Bubbles) we will be offering one online lesson with a class teacher each day, to ensure that we do not have any clashes and as many children as possible can attend. The times for the lessons are as follows:
