<p>Starting with a story....</p> <p>Watch the video in Tapestry of the story of Chinese New Year.</p> <p>It can also be found in cBeebies Let’s Celebrate here: https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/watch/chinese-new-year</p>	<p>Writing focus activity</p> <p>At Chinese New Year people make good wishes for the coming year and for their friends and family which they hang on special wishing trees.</p> <p>Have a go at writing your own new year wish for your family or a friend.</p>	<p>Maths focus activity – extra to White Rose if needed</p> <p>Put the animals from the story in the right order for their position in the race. Can you remember / work out who was first/ second/ third etc.</p> <p>There is an activity to print out on the website or it will be provided in your pack if you have asked for one. You can always have a go at drawing the animals too!</p>

Use your construction at home to build the Great Wall of China. How long can you make it? What construction works best – lego, bricks, magnetic shapes? Can you use chopsticks or may spoon handles to pick up different objects e.g. pasta / pom poms/ lego. How many can you move into a container in one minute?</p> <p>Create your own dragon dance using the song Miss Cother will share on Tapestry. There will also be a film added for you to watch.</p>
