- Retell a story and a simple narrative.
- Sequence a story.
- Write a clear sentence using capital letter, full stop and fingers spaces.
- Use capital letters for people, places and names.
- Extend and join sentences with simple connective – ‘but’
- Use ‘ing’ and ‘ed’ words confidently in sentences.
- Use ‘un’ words confidently in sentences.
- Rehearse their sentence orally before writing it down.
- Remember to use their phonics when writing.

Maths

- Multiplication and division.
- Fractions.
- Place value (to 100).
- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.

Science

- Identify and name a variety of common wild plants and garden plants.
- Identify the basic structure of a plant.
- Identify and name a variety of deciduous and evergreen plants.
- Identify changes within the season and the senses I use.
- Know what plants need to grow.
- Monitor changes over time -growing plants.

Geography

- Read a map.
- Identify symbols on maps.
- Draw a simple map with a key.
- Explain my journey to school.

Art

- Name primary and secondary colours.

History

- Identify objects from the past and its use.
- Identify and label the parts of a castle.
- Identify and describe people’s lives in a castle.

PE

- Perform a range of skills using a variety of equipment.
- Show an awareness of space and learn how to work collaboratively.
- Use varying speeds.

Computing

- Access the internet safely and know what to do if I’m not happy with something.
- Begin to understand algorithms as a set of instructions.

PSHEC

- Be aware of behaviour in other people that I appreciate or don’t like and how it makes us feel.
- Relationships – Who’s in my family? What do other families look like? How can I be a good friend?

Music

- Identify instruments and the way their sound can be changes.
