If you are staying for our Look & Learn Together sessions please:

- Let your child come in on their own whilst you sign yourself and any younger children in. Miss Cother & Mrs Cooper will have signing in sheets in our covered area outside.
- Join in with your child wherever they are playing/working. Activities out on the tables will link to the weekly focus and we will give you additional information on a separate sheet at the end of the session which we hope will give you ideas to use at home.
- Feel free to ask us questions about the activities but do remember that this is not an opportunity to discuss your child's progress or any concerns you may have. Please catch us at another time or make an appointment to do this if you need to.
- Let younger brothers and sisters play but please remember that you need to keep an eye on them. We are set up for school age children and there are small things in the classrooms! If you have a pram or pushchair please leave it outside under our cover unless there is a sleeping child in it of course!
- **We must ask that you follow our school policy on use of mobile phones during the session and that mobile phones must not be used in school. Please do not take any photographs during the Look and Learn session.**
- At 9.15 a.m. we will ring our bells for tidy up time. This will be the end of the session and one of us will take you all through school to the front entrance together. If you need to leave any earlier then please ask a member of staff who will escort you through the school building, we have to do this as part of our school safeguarding procedures.

Finally, enjoy yourselves and get involved; the children are so excited about showing you what we do and what they can do.
